2004 Cabernet Sauvignon

In 2004 all of our estate fruit was devastated by the freeze and frost, but we were very fortunate to find some Walla Walla Valley Cabernet Sauvignon from the Panoramic Vineyard. This site shows a more intense herbaceous characteristic than our estate sites, but we are glad to be able to make wine with fruit from our valley. This is the only wine in our 2004 red line up from of the Walla Walla Valley.

Cabernet Sauvignon is often called the "King" of wines, and for good reason. There are aristocratic layers of complexity and delight in this well structured wine. The dark ruby red color foretells of the richness of the wine. The wine exhibits classic notes of dried cherries and red currants present on the nose while the palate is a complex mix of dark fruit with a pleasant tar and tobacco finish. The wine has a firm acidity, balanced by fruit notes and supple tannin structure with a long, lingering finish.

Enjoy this wine with a hunter's stew or a filet mignon topped with Walla Walla sweet onions.
