2006 Estate Syrah Walla Walla Valley

An extremely versatile grape varietal, Syrah can be coaxed into a myriad of different styles, from the rich and earthy Rhône and Hermitage wines of France to the fruit bomb Shiraz wines of Australia, and the big power houses from the States.

If you liked our 2005 Syrah, which Wine & Spirits Magazine rated one of the "94 Greats from Around the World," get ready to love the 2006 vintage.

Our 2006 Ash Hollow Estate Syrah is "Old World" in style with a little "New World" attitude. Notes of blackberries and blueberry pie are joined by hints of roasted duck on the nose. Blasting with flavor the intense fruit on the front of the palate is balanced with dark chocolate and rich tobacco flavor that goes on and on. Elegance and power are a match made in heaven for this wine.



This Syrah is 100% from Ash Hollow Vineyard. The wine is barrel aged for twelve months in 60% French Oak and 40% Hungarian Oak of which approximately 25% was new. The wine is unfiltered and unfined.

Nicely balanced and multi-layered, this wine is very drinkable upon release, but will also age well for the next 6-9 years. Syrah pairs best with meals of similar weight and texture. Try our Syrah with slowly braised lamb shanks with dried plums, apricots and raisins.
